Working in partnership with Eastbourne Foodbank

Foodbanks are not the solution to rising poverty. Our small team of advisers works with foodbank clients to establish why they are unable to afford to buy food. We take a cash-first approach through our welfare benefits and debt advice service, working with clients to make sure they are receiving their full benefit entitlement and any debts are managed. When people have sufficient income they do not need to use the foodbank.

As a referral partner, your agency issues foodbank vouchers to clients who are experiencing crisis and need emergency food. There will usually be a named person in your organisation who is responsible for generating foodbank vouchers.

The best way to use a foodbank voucher is as an emergency support mechanism alongside the work you are doing with your client to resolve their crisis. If another service or agency's support is needed to provide specialist help, the client should be referred or signposted to this support with foodbank vouchers issued alongside as and when required.

When a client is experiencing crisis, issuing a foodbank voucher in isolation is unlikely to be the most effective solution.

Guidance before issuing a food voucher

Before issuing a foodbank voucher to a client, agencies should consider the following

Do you know the reason for your client's financial difficulty?

If your client is experiencing minor, temporary financial issues, have you recommended a local Pantry rather than one of our foodbanks?

Guidance when issuing a food voucher

Preparing clients for a foodbank visit

A first visit to a foodbank can be a daunting or overwhelming experience. Please prepare your client for a visit to one of our foodbanks by informing them that:

- Everyone who visits a foodbank will be made to feel welcome and will be treated equally
- No one will be judged
- We know that people visit foodbanks for lots of different reasons
- Additional support is available at all our main foodbanks, including welfare benefits and debt advice

Guidance when issuing a food voucher

For clients who are unwell and unable to leave their homes, a delivery service can be available.

Where a client is able to visit a foodbank in person, the voucher should be issued for their nearest or preferred foodbank satellite.

Visiting in person gives clients the opportunity to choose their own food, meet with an advocate if they need to and have a social experience over a cup of tea with a snack.

If your client needs in-depth help and you're unable to provide it, or another agency can't help, please speak to one of our advocates to make an appointment at our Grove Road Advice Centre for your client.

Our advocates provide a confidential and free service which consists of in-depth knowledge of the welfare benefits system and debt support services. Even a small change to a client's financial circumstances can make a huge difference.
